Estate Matters:

Refuse Chute Blockages

The estate porters are still regularly clearing refuse chute blockages which have been caused by inappropriate objects being put down the chutes. If a bag or item appears too big for the chute, please do not force it down. Items such as card board boxes, large collections of books or magazines, or large plastic bottles, should be recycled. Finally, please don't put any cookware such as pots and pans down the chutes either.

Recycling

When filling your recycling bags, please ensure that you only put the permitted items inside for collection. For example, polystyrene is not recyclable and you can no longer recycle shredded paper either.
